




Lead-in 5.1 km (92 hm)






Loop 38 km (432 hm)

3 - Route - General Info

- Official qualifier distance UCI Gravel
 World Championships
 - Men 60+ & women 50+ → 85 km
 - Elite, men 19-59 & women 19-49 →
 123 km

- Elevation gain:
 - 85 km → 1003 hm (two loops)
 - 123 km → 1435 hm (three loops)





3 - Route

- Mix of climbs like the Cauberg, technical descents, gravel, lössgrond and tarmac roads
- Two feed zones with (limited) technical support per loop (19 km apart)
- GPX files will be shared one week prior to the event







3 - Bikes, spares and tools

- The event is self-reliant. Bring your own tools and spare parts. Other problems can be fixed in the feed zones, limited tools are available. You can change wheels during the race, not your bike
- You may use any type of bike gravel bike, road bike, mountain bike - with the exception of tandem, recumbent bikes and time trial road bikes







4 - Race regulations

- To start in this qualifying event:
 - a UCl or day license is mandatory!
- Please check all <u>race regulations</u>
- Note: When qualified for the Worlds:
 - at the World Championships you will need an annual (national) license with UCl ID, so **no** day license possible





4 - Categories

- Elite men & women
- Age groups
 - 19 34y men & women
 - o 35 39y men & women
 - 40 44y men & women
 - 45 49y men & women
 - 50 54y men & women
 - o Etc.

Age Groups applicable to the Gravel World Series are defined by the rider's age on Dec 31 of the year of the qualifier event

4 - Registration procedure

Registration location inside (follow signs):
 Shimano Experience Center

Friday April 26 12h00 - 19h00
 Saturday April 27 12h00 - 18h00
 Sunday April 28 06h30 - 08h00

 Please have your QR code and (if applicable) UCI licence ready when you're at the registration desk





4 - Registration procedure

- To start a UCI or day license is mandatory!
- Two separate queues: UCI including check and day license. Follow the signs
- Start package: number plate including chip and bib number





5 - Starting procedure

- Start in waves based on categories
- A preferred start box with selected riders (max of 25 riders). Only applicable for Elite category men & women
- The start position after the preferred start box and Elite category men & women will be based on age group
- All different starts will have different gun times





5 - Starting procedure

Starting times

- o 08:30 Priority box men + men elite
- 08:31 Priority box women + women elite
- 08:33 Age category 19 34y
- 08:35 Age category 35 39y
- 08:37 Age category 40 44y
- 08:39 Age category 45 49y
- o 08:41 Age category 50 54y
- o 08:43 Age category 55 59y
- o 08:45 Age category 60 64y
- o 08:47 Age category 65 69y
- o 08:49 Age category 70 74y
- 08:51 Age category 75 79y





5 - Preferred start box

- Only applicable for Elite riders
- The race director allocates the spots
- The selection on the list is unrecallable and undisputable
- Do NOT contact us and question the selection





6 - UCI Worlds Qualifying

- Qualification for the UCI Gravel World Championships for those riders finishing in the first 25% of the Elite and Age Categories
- The 25% is calculated based on the number of starters in each category, and not on the number of riders having finished the race. Qualification is always per category and based on category results, not on overall results





6 - UCI Worlds Qualifying

- Results will be shared directly after finish at the UCI Qualifying desk
- Winners will receive a UCI Jersey (per category)
- Qualifiers will get a UCI Qualifiers medal (to be picked up on event only)
- All riders will receive a finishers badge



- Bike washing station available






8 - Practicalities
